## MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE CITY OF ELY COUNCIL HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER AT 7.00 PM ON MONDAY 29TH JULY 2013

The Mayor reported to members that Cllr Eden and Cllr Burton had both resigned from the Council. Cllr Eden had been a councillor since February 2001 and had been the Mayor during 2003-2004. Cllr Burton had joined the Council in May 2007 and had been Mayor during 2012-2013. She proposed a vote of thanks to both of them for all the hard work and effort they had contributed to the Council and the community over their years in office.

Apologies were received from Cllrs Ashton and Overall.

### 2. COUNCILLOR REQUESTS FOR DISPENSATIONS

There were no requests for dispensations.

### 4. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING HELD ON THE 1ST JULY AND MATTERS ARISING

The minutes of the last meeting held on the 1st July were agreed and signed as a true record. Pages 1270, 1271, 1272, 1273 and 1274 refer.

Matters arising:- Page 1273, item 15 – Cllr Yates informed members he had received further information regarding Steeple Row, which was not as he had originally been lead to believe. Therefore, he would be clarifying this with East Cambs District Council.

Page 1275, item 19 – The Mayor reported that the sale of the Magistrates Court had now completed and the building belonged to the Council.

Page 1275, item 20 – The Mayor reported the garden at the Maltings Cottage had now been cut.

Page 1273, item 17 - Members noted the update from ECDC regarding the Ely Riverside Mooring Byelaw.

#### **5. OUESTION TIME**

The Mayor informed those present that items 11 (Allotments) and 16 would be discussed in Committee at the end of the meeting. Due to the confidential nature of these items, members of the public would be excluded from the meeting.

Cllr Rouse, in his capacity as a County councillor, informed members that he was looking at the issue on Shape Your Place, regarding lorries in King's Avenue. He had also asked Mr Hughes from ECDC to arrange a meeting with Cambs County Council as a new bus stop standing in King's Avenue had been installed, but cars were actually parking in front of it. The Clerk informed members she had raised concerns with Sainsburys regarding their delivery lorries using Broad Street as a route to the store and not via Prickwillow Road. She had been assured by

She had also visited various organisations such as Kaptiv8 Academy, Ely Aquarius Gateway Club and the Cambridge and Ely Child Contact Centre.

The Deputy Mayor had attended the opening of the new Ely Sixth Form Common Room.

#### 9. COMMITTEE REPORTS

- (i) ADMINISTRATION The Mayor presented a report of a meeting held on the 15th July, which was approved. Members noted that the Working Group to review the Council's forms of communications would meet with Mr Block and Mr Pittock, following their presentation on the ElyAce, to discuss how to promote the Council on this app. Members noted the revised Committee Structure and subject to the removal of the Asset & Acquisitions Committee Chairman from the Finance & Personnel Committee this was unanimously approved. Members approved the new application form for the co-option of councillors. Members agreed to take out another ESPO contract for 5 years for a new photocopier. Resident only parking signs for Ramsey Road will be purchased. Members noted the Internal Auditor's report from his last visit on the 15th May. There were no issues for concern. Members approved the recommendation that Cllr Yates be appointed to represent this Council on a small Working Party, being formed by the Perspective Group, to move the Steeple Row project forward.
- (ii) STREET FURNITURE No report as Committee had not met. The next meeting is on the 19th August. The Clerk gave an update on the bus shelter for Lancaster Way.
- (iii)RECREATION & CEMETERY No report as Committee had not met. Cllr Clarke reported that the new play equipment had been installed at St John's Road play area. The order had been placed for the new skate ramps at St John's Road and the new fence for the St John's Road play area was being erected today. The third quote for the new paths in the Cemetery had been received. The lowest quote was therefore accepted from Greys Surfacing.
- (iv) CHRISTMAS LIGHTS No report as Committee had not met. The next meeting will be on the 16th September. Cllr Chaplin agreed to speak to Mr Newstead regarding the arrangements for the switch-on evening as Philip Eden had resigned as a councillor and had been involved with this.
- (v) ELY IN BLOOM No report as Committee had not met. The next meeting will be on the 24th September. Judging for the Ely in Bloom competitions will take place on the 7th August, with the prize giving on the 20th August.

(vii)YOUTH FORUM – Cllr Yates presented a report of a meeting held on the 23rd July, which was approved. Cllr Yates informed members that permission was now being sought from the Cathedral to hold the next Youth Fair on the 14th September on Cross Green, rather than on the High Street. This request was being considered on the 30th July by the Cathedral.

(viii) CITY CENTRE FORUM – Cllr Mackay presented a report of a meeting held on the 10th July, which was approved. Cllr Mackay informed members that the Forum were looking at the possibility of providing a park and ride service for the five weeks up to Christmas. During this period the Cathedral would also be holding a Christmas Fayre. She will identify councillors to put together possible scenarios and costs for discussion at the next Full Council meeting.

#### 10. WORKING PARTIES/STEERING GROUPS REPORTS

CCTV Partnership Steering Group – notes of a meeting held on the 25th June were noted.

On-Street Parking Working Party – members noted the list of faults regarding street signage and lines in the City Centre, which had been tabled. These will be forwarded to relevant parties and they will be invited to attend a meeting to look at these issues in more detail.

### 12. TO MAKE COMMENTS ON PROPOSED WAITING RESTRICTIONS IN THE PADDOCK, ELY

Members considered the proposals for waiting restrictions in The Paddock, Ely and had no objections to these, subject to all the residents being in favour of them.

## 13. TO CONSIDER A REQUEST FOR STREET NAMING OF NEW STREET OFF LYNN ROAD, ELY

Members considered the request to name a new street off Lynn Road, Ely after the recently deceased Inspector Alan Savill. Members although they did not object to the suggestion of Sherriff Gardens or Close, they felt that not many people would know the connection with Alan Savill and him being known as the Sheriff of Ely. They felt it would be much better to actually name if after him, so suggested Savill Gardens or Close. If the area was appropriate even Savill Court.

## 14. TO APPROVE THE APPOINTMENT OF CLLR EVERY AS THE COUNCIL'S REPRESENTATIVE ON THE GOVERNING BODY OF ELY ST JOHN'S PRIMARY SCHOOL
