1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

3. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING HELD ON 20^{TH} JANUARY 2020 AND MATTERS ARISING

5.1 Willow Walk

5.3 TO CONSIDER REQUEST FROM FORDHAM PARISH COUNCIL

Members considered the request from Fordham Parish Council to support seeking a Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO). Members agreed that the Council would not support this request as the City of Ely Council's open spaces do not experience the problems being encountered by Fordham Parish Council.

5.4 TO CONSIDER REQUEST REGARDING A SPLASH PAD

Members noted the email received from the group of residents who have requested a Splash Pad in the City. Cllr C Whelan advised she will be attending a meeting with the group to hear more about their request. Members agreed that the options suggested in the email were not suitable and that a more ideal location would be Jubilee Gardens.
