- 5 The Chase, Ely Construction of single storey rear extension and alterations to existing dwelling.
- 39 Chiefs Street, Ely Proposed conversion of existing garage to annexe.
- 4 Bohemond Street, Ely Proposed garage conversion, removal of front porch conservatory, alterations to windows and doors and external boarding.
- Ely Leisure Village, Downham Road, Ely Variation of condition 1 (Approved plans) of previously approved 17/00385/VAR3M for Variation of condition 1 (Approved plans) or previously approved 16/00372/RM3M for approval of the detailed appearance, landscaping, layout and scale for the construction of a district wide leisure centre. Plot 207, Lancaster Way Business Park, Ely To vary Conditions 1 (Approved plans), 3 (External Materials), 5 (Use Classes), 6 (Parking and Turning), 7 (Cycle Parking), 8 (Electric Vehicle Charging Points), 11 (External Lighting), 13 (Solar Panels), 14 (Landscaping), and 15 (Pedestrian Crossings) of previously approved 21/01410/RMM for Reserved matters for Erection of E(g), B2 and B8 industrial building, with ancillary office, warehouse, service yard, plant, PV panels external lighting, electric vehicle charging points, car park and cycle parking, including site entrance and associated infrastructure. The original application was EIA development and an ES was provided at that time, of previously approved 08/00563/ESO for the Extension to Lancaster Way Business Park including infrastructure, roads services yards, drainage and landscape works.
- 1 Beech Lane, Ely Gl Silver Birch, Holly Tree, False Acacia Cut down to clear space for summer house/shed. St Johns Manor, 1 St Johns Road, Ely T1 Sycamore Fell due to decay and damage to historic wall T2 Sycamore Fell due to causing structural damage to grade 1 listed monastic building.
- 17 New Barns Road, Ely External wall insulation with smooth white render and replacement of drains and gutters. Addition of fence at side of house.
- 29 Chapel Street, Ely T1 Acer Remove to due to slow decline in health T2 Cherry Trim back to boundary fence. Balagowan, 34 Downham Road, Ely T1 Cherry Fell as dying.
- 3a The Cloisters, Ely Existing facia sign "STARBUCKS COFFEE" to be replaced with facia sign "STARBUCKS" with new trough lighting.
- 9 Egremont Street, Ely New garden studio and associated infrastructure to include rear garden path and soft landscaping.
- High Flyer Farm, Lynn Road, Ely T1 Ash Reduce crown by 5m in height and up to 4m in spread. Recent and historic limb shedding in evidence. Decay in scaffold limbs with numerous woodpecker holes visible from ground level. Scattered deadwood throughout crown. Infected with Ash Heart Rot (Inonotus hispidus).

5-5a Annesdale, Ely – 2 externally illuminated fascia signs – retrospective.

(ii) Refused Applications

Brendon, 22 Lisle Lane, Ely – Proposed removal of carport and construction of two storey extension.

Hithertree House, Nornea Lane, Stuntney - Demolition of one dwelling and outbuildings, and replace with a 5 bed self-build detached dwelling, garage and associated infrastructure.

(iii) Appeals Decisions – APP/V0510/X/21/3281916 - 17 Tower Court, Tower Road, Ely - to replace the internal doors with wood effect doors and to remove the existing floor coverings and install wood effect vinyl planks with underlay to floor surface of combined kitchen and lounge. *The appeal is allowed*.
