TABLE OF FEES 2023/24

The fees set out below apply where the person to be interred was immediately before his or her death a parishioner of the City of Ely. In the case of a stillborn child, the parents must be resident of the Parish.

The body of a non-parishioner is accepted from outside of the Parish, if they had a close connection to Ely. For these the fees are doubled for residents of East Cambridgeshire and tripled for residents outside of the District. In these cases, **all fees are either doubled or tripled** whichever is applicable. These fees also apply if the Exclusive Right to Burial had been purchased at an earlier date and the resident had left the Parish.

The Exclusive Right to Burial in Ely Cemetery must be acquired at the time of interment and cannot be pre-purchased. With the exception of an adjacent grave within section Con E, where only signal depth graves are permitted, the Exclusive Right to Burial for this must be purchased at the time of the first interment. For an existing grave, ownership must be confirmed as either being the recently deceased or be a living relative who is named on the Exclusive Right to Burial Document. If this is not the case then the ownership must be transferred prior to the interment taking place.

Please ensure payment is made to the Council at least 3 clear working days prior to interment.

Please check your payment is correct as a charge of £22.00 will be made for any incorrect or late payments. You will be notified of this charge when we contact you to inform you of the correct charge or if your payment is late and invoiced accordingly.

PART 1 INTERMENT (including digging of the grave)

Funerals after 2.30pm from Monday to Thursday and after 2pm on a Friday and also at weekends or public holidays will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Additional charges for these are listed below.**

Depending on individual circumstances additional charges may be made. If a grave requires hand digging, then the fee will be doubled.

Please be advised some areas of the cemetery are prone to flooding which can restrict burials after substantial rainfall, these areas are monitored by staff but occasionally funerals may need to be postponed, sometimes at short notice.
